UPOLET GUIDELINES 2020

1. Students who scored at least division three in UCE 2019 will be eligible to benefit under UPOLET.
2. Students will offer 3 principal subjects and 2 subsidiaries.
3. Students will be required to choose between computer studies as a subsidiary and subsidiary Mathematics in addition to General paper.
4. All students offering principle mathematics will be required to take computer studies at subsidiary level (Skills Development Strategy).
5. Students offering economics without principle mathematics will take on subsidiary mathematics.
6. All those offering science combination without principle mathematics will take on subsidiary mathematics.
7. No student will be allowed to take a subject in a subject combination where he/she has scored above Credit 6 and the total aggregates in the combination of 3 subjects must not exceed 18.
8. A candidate is considered on the basis of three (3) subjects, which form combination
9. At least a credit in Mathematics should be the basis for an Arts combination which includes Economics. A weak credit in Mathematics must be backed by at least a credit three in Commerce or accounts.

N.B: There will be an opportunity to amended eligibility for those not qualifying for the above offer. However there will be a charge of 223,000/= per term.
